How can you help support your child?

English

We will be focussing on The Great Fire of London. The children will be writing in lots of different styles including a newspaper report, a diary entry, and historical facts. We will also use drama to support the children's learning in this exciting topic.

Maths

We will be focussing on subtraction and will use our topic to think about and compare measurement. We will continue to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and will encourage the children to form their numbers correctly. We will also begin to look at money in practical terms.

TOPIC

Our focus will be the Great Fire of London and looking at the lives of famous historical people. We have set a homework project of building a Tudor house. You can be as creative as you wish and any size is acceptable! There is a model outside Skyworld Class to help with ideas and this, as well as many other projects, will all be shared as part of our Time Travellers Day — See Diary Date on the back of this newsletter. 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Science

The children will continue to observe seasonal changes as well as identify and group animals native to Britain. We will also look at the effect heat and cold has on everyday materials and even using yeast to make bread.

RE

The focus this term will be the story of the Nativity and will include music, art and drama.
