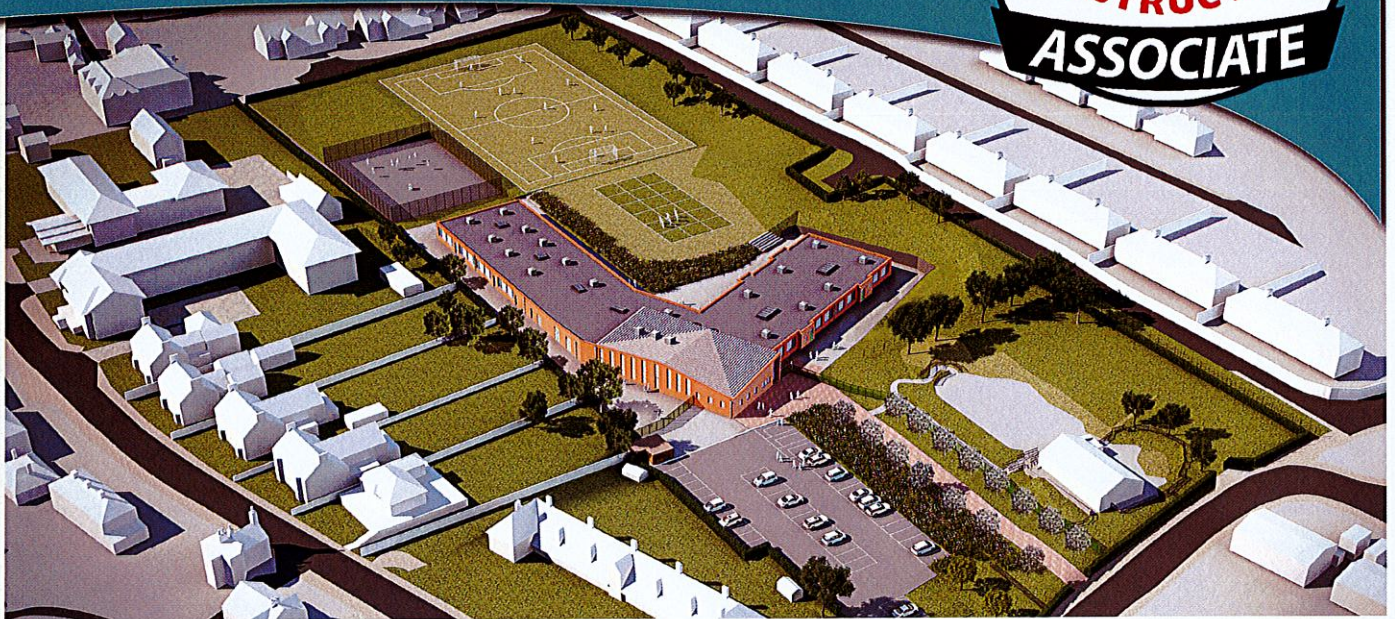

## Introduction

Welcome to the third issue of our newsletter, the 'Marlborough Mail', to keep you informed of the progress at St Mary's School.

## Progress update

Building foundations are complete and the single storey steel frame has commenced. The majority of the site has been reshaped with areas already top soiled, awaiting seeding or planting next year. Drainage works have commenced.

To answer a previously raised query, please be assured that the drainage design will not have an impact on the existing drainage services. All of the rainwater collected from the building roof and hard landscaped areas will be directed to a large volume attenuation system, below the hard play area. This will store and allow slow dispersion of the water. Kier's site offices and welfare facilities are established so there is no further need for the generator to power our facilities.

## Next operations

Upon completion of the steel frame, the roof will progress from early November. The ground floor slabs will then be prepared and concreted.

We have made contact with the Wiltshire Environmental Health Department concerning our need to 'power float' the slab. Unfortunately, this will entail a couple of nights working 'out of hours'. Once agreements are in place and actual dates are known, we will provide an update.

## Neighbourly consideration

The project, like all of Kier Construction sites, is registered under the Considerate Constructors Scheme (CCS), which monitors and scores the site against their code of practice. Our first inspection will be carried out in the next few weeks.

We continue to monitor potential noisy and dusty operations in an effort to minimise inconvenience and we hope we have been successful in doing this so far.

Thank you for your patience while we construct the new education facilities in your area.
