English

Our topic this term is Enchantment and we will be using texts such as Beauty and the Beast, Zog and How to Train your Dragon to inspire the children with their writing. We will focus on using adjectives and connectives to improve the detail in our writing. The children will continue to use group and partner work to share ideas.

Maths

Our focus will be on spotting patterns in number including halving and doubling. We will continue to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and will encourage the children to form their numbers correctly. We will work on measure, money and fractions as part of the topic as well as begin to understand how to understand word problems.

TOPIC

Our topic this term is Enchantment and so lots of mythical beasts, spells and potions are on the agenda! The children will be engaging in lots of exciting activities including producing a multi media presentation in ICT. They will use a variety of materials in art to create models and pictures. We will explore mood and tempo as part of music and during science we will learn the best way to keep a dragon's blood frozen!

This term we will continue to observe change with a focus on everyday materials. Children will learn the definition of a solid, a gas and a liquid. We will also look at reversible and irreversible change through fun activities such as melting wax crayons to create a picture.

RE

The focus this term will be Christianity and will include music, art and drama.
