English: Ready, steady, raid! We will be creating our own information books about the Vikings before we use drama to explore preparing and carrying out a Viking raid! Is your classroom safe? These experiences will be put to good use to create vivid and dramatic diaries about Viking life, including raiding other lands! Maybe you will be a Viking who settled in a new land and will need to write a letter home about your new life! Plus create your own Norse myth!

Maths: A range of topics will continue to be taught throughout the term with topics from Number, Shape, Data and Measures. We will continue to develop our mental arithmetic skills to ensure we have a range of strategies to solve problems and to continue to embed our number bonds and multiplication facts, including using inverses.

ICT: Year 5 will be tackling a computing project; refining sequences and algorithms.

Year 6 will returning to the Cyber Café and looking at safety when using technology.

Music: Create your own Viking Saga with a powerful beat and rhythm!

RE: Does belief in Akirah (life after death) help Muslims to lead good lives? We will be learning about the ways Muslims lead good lives and how Akirah influences this.
