Use the enclosed A4 paper or any colour choice of your own, and encourage your child/children to create some artwork. **PLEASE READ THE ARTWORK GUIDELINES ON THE ORDER FORM - THESE HIGHLIGHT WHICH MATERIALS PRODUCE THE BEST RESULTS AND WHICH NOT TO USE (TO INCLUDE METALLIC PENS OR PAINT AND PHOTOS ON GLOSSY PAPER.)**

The finished cards are accurate, colour reproductions of the artwork submitted, approximately 4" x 6" and have the child's name and school on the back. Examples of which can be found in the information stand by the school reception.

Once you have decided upon a piece of artwork, you need to follow these next steps:

1. Complete the order form and attach your child's artwork with Pritt Stick, **no Sellotape, staples or paper clips as this will spoil the artwork.**
2. Each separate piece of artwork needs its own order form. Please pick up additional forms from reception if you need more.
3. Enclose your payment in an **envelope with your child's name and class written on it** - cheques made payable to the **Friends of Marlborough St Mary's** - or cash. Prices details are on the order form.
4. Return artwork, forms and money to the school reception before **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October. NO LATE ENTRIES.**

All cards will be delivered back to the school at the beginning of December.
