As with previous years, children will start school on a phased induction during the month of September. We have planned our induction timetable very carefully and have been mindful of the disruption already caused due to the ongoing Covid situation. With this in mind we have decided not to allocate children to classes in the first term of school, instead allowing the children to mix as a cohort, get to know each other and staff and then allocate classes ready for term 2. This will be explained in further detail at our Welcome meeting, which we hope we can re-schedule. We are also inviting all parents to accept a **Home Visit** during the first weeks of September. In the past we have found these to be particularly valuable for all concerned. The children respond very well to their teachers visiting them on home ground and love to share their toys and chat; they are often more themselves in this environment. We will notify you in due course how we are going to schedule these.
