### Class Dojo



This is our whole school communication platform enabling us to communicate information, events and learning. Before the summer holidays you will receive an invitation to sign up and log in. We will then be able to send reminders and information during the holidays and you will be able to share photographs of summer fun for us to share when we start school.
